- **YOU WILL BE ASKED TO REMOVE ANY ITEMS NOT LISTED ON APPLICATION.**
- We reserve the right to limit the number of vendors selling the same type of products. Booth space is first-come-first served. Special requests will be taken into consideration during assignment, **HOWEVER A SPECIFIC SPOT CANNOT BE GUARANTEED.**
- This is an outdoor event. Summer heat, rain and wind can occur. Be prepared.
- Animals of any type are **NOT** permitted at the fair unless an authorization has been granted.
- **SIDEWALKS MUST BE KEPT CLEAR AT ALL TIMES ESPECIALLY ON CASTLE ST.**
- **MARKED FIRE LANES MUST BE KEPT CLEAR AT ALL TIMES.**
- Electrical cords and hoses **MUST** be run along the gutter to the source **and MUST** be taped down in areas where people will be walking (across sidewalks, driveways, etc).
- Vendors will be provided with load-in and load out procedures and **ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLY WITH THESE PROCEDURES.**
