Note: Campfires allowed in designated campgrounds **without** permit. Campfires allowed in dispersed campsites **with** permit.

Bunny Flat (6900') Across from parking lot, self-made campsites. No fee. 3-day stay. 11 miles from Mt. Shasta City on Everitt Memorial Hwy at Bunny Flat Trailhead. Restrooms but no drinking water.

Castle Lake (6450') **ALL CAMPING IS PROHIBITED WITHIN A HALF A MILE OF CASTLE LAKE DAY USE AREA.**

6 wooded sites on unpaved road. No fee. From I-5, 10 miles west of Mt. Shasta City. Take W.A. Barr Road; cross box Canyon Dam; Turn Left onto Castle Lake Rd. Camp ½ mile below lake. Trailers not advised. Portable restrooms but no drinking water. Nearby creek water must be treated. Fishing, swimming, hiking. No motorboats allowed. Must pack out garbage. Closed winter. Limit: 7 days.

Gumboot Lake (6000') Several users created sites. Toilets: no water, so bring your own. 7-day stay limit. No Fee. From I-5, 20 miles west of Mt. Shasta City. Take W.A. Barr Road left on unpaved Red Fir Rd. Trailer length 10' only. Fishing OK. No motor boats. Pack out all garbage.

McBride Springs (5000') 14 sites: tables, fire rings, and toilet. No water just yet, so bring your own. 7-days stay limit; first come basis, \$10/night. From I-5 five miles east of Mt. Shasta City on Everitt Memorial Hwy (A-10) Trailer length 10' only.

Panther Meadow (7400') 10 timberline tent sites. No fee/no water. 14 miles east of city near end of Everitt Memorial Hwy. (A-10) Restroom but no drinking water. No RV sites. Must pack in camping gear from parking lot to camp site and pack out all garbage. **NO DISPERSED CAMPING.** Closed Winter. Limit: 3-day stay max.

Sims Flat (1600') 20 Sites with tables, fire rings, water, toilets, hiking, and access to the Sacramento River. 14-days stay limit; first come basis. \$15/night. 20 miles south of Mt. Shasta City via I-5 at Sims Flat exit.

Ah-Di-Nah (2300') 20 sites; tables, fire rings, water, and toilets. 14-day stay limit; first come basis. \$10/night. Off Hwy 89 on Squaw Valley Rd. 4 miles south of Lake McCloud on river.

Algoma (3800') 8 sites. 14 miles east of McCloud off Hwy 89 on River Loop Road. Open as weather permits. No drinking water. No fee.

Cattle Camp (3700') 20 sites. Tables, fire rings, water, and toilets. 14- day stay limit. \$15/night; first come basis. 11 mi. E. of McCloud off Hwy 89 on paved River Loop Rd.

Fowlers Camp (3600') 32 sites: tables, fire rings, water, and toilets. 14 days stay limit: \$15/night. Sites are by reservation only at www.recreation.gov 8 sites are at a first come basis. Located 5 miles East of McCloud, off Hwy 89 on paved River Loop Road.

Harris Springs (4800') 15 sites, 17 north of Bartle off Hwy 89. Pit toilet, no water. Open March through Oct. No fee.

Trout Creek (4800') 10 sites. 17 mi NE of McCloud off Pilgrim Creek Rd. No drinking water. Pit toilet. Open when weather permits. No fees.

Where: 15 miles south of Mt. Shasta City off Interstate 5; take Castella Exit
Sites: 67 tent sites, 3 RV sites (up to 27' long), 6 trailer sites (up to 21' long). No hookups or dumping sites. 2000' elevation.
Facilities: Restrooms, hot showers, hiking, nature trails, rock climbing, swimming, picnicking. Open all year.
