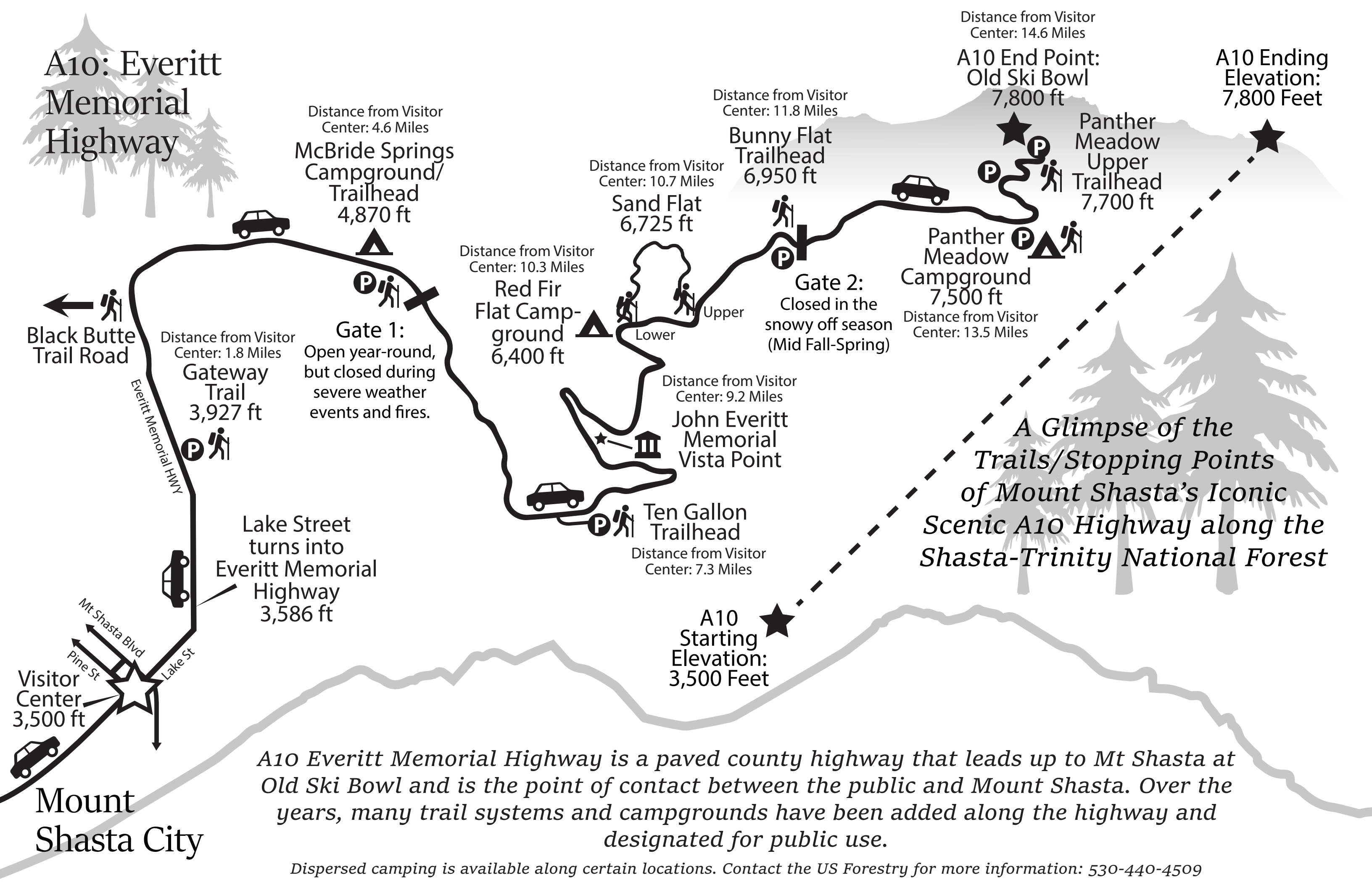


A10: Everitt Memorial Highway

A10 Everitt Memorial Highway is a paved county highway that leads up to Mt Shasta at Old Ski Bowl and is the point of contact between the public and Mount Shasta. Over the years, many trail systems and campgrounds have been added along the highway and designated for public use.
